
Quick-Fit Dowel (28)

Wood Dowel (18) Cam Locks (32)


Long Connector Bolt (2)

You will need: Phillips Screwdriver


- 1.) Insert the Quick-Fit Dowels into the <u>inside</u> holes shown on the top, bottom (with small pilot holes), and side panels. NOTE: Do NOT install Quick-Fit Dowels to the center panel (holes drilled all the way through).
- 2.) Insert the Wood Dowels into the <u>outside</u> holes shown on the top, bottom, side, and center panels. For the center panels: Push the dowel through the hole so that the same amount extends on both sides.




3.) Insert the Cam Locks into the larger holes on the back, side, and center panels. Make sure the arrow on the Cam Lock is pointing towards the predrilled hole in side of panel.



4.) Insert the Long Connector Bolts into one of the back panels. Slide center panel over Long Connector Bolts. Note: Arrow on center panel must point up.




5.) Slide the other back panel over the exposed ends of the Long Connector Bolts. Tighten all four Cam Locks by turning clockwise.




6.) Attach both side panels to this assembly by sliding the Quick-Fit Dowels into the pre-drilled holes on the edge of the back panel. Tighten the Cam Locks by turning clockwise.


Note: Arrow on side panels must point up.




7.) Attach the bottom panel, tightening the Cam Locks in the same manner.



8.) Attach the Casters using the pre-drilled holes. Be sure to lock Casters before flipping cabinet back over.



9.) Flip the cabinet over and attach the top panel.
